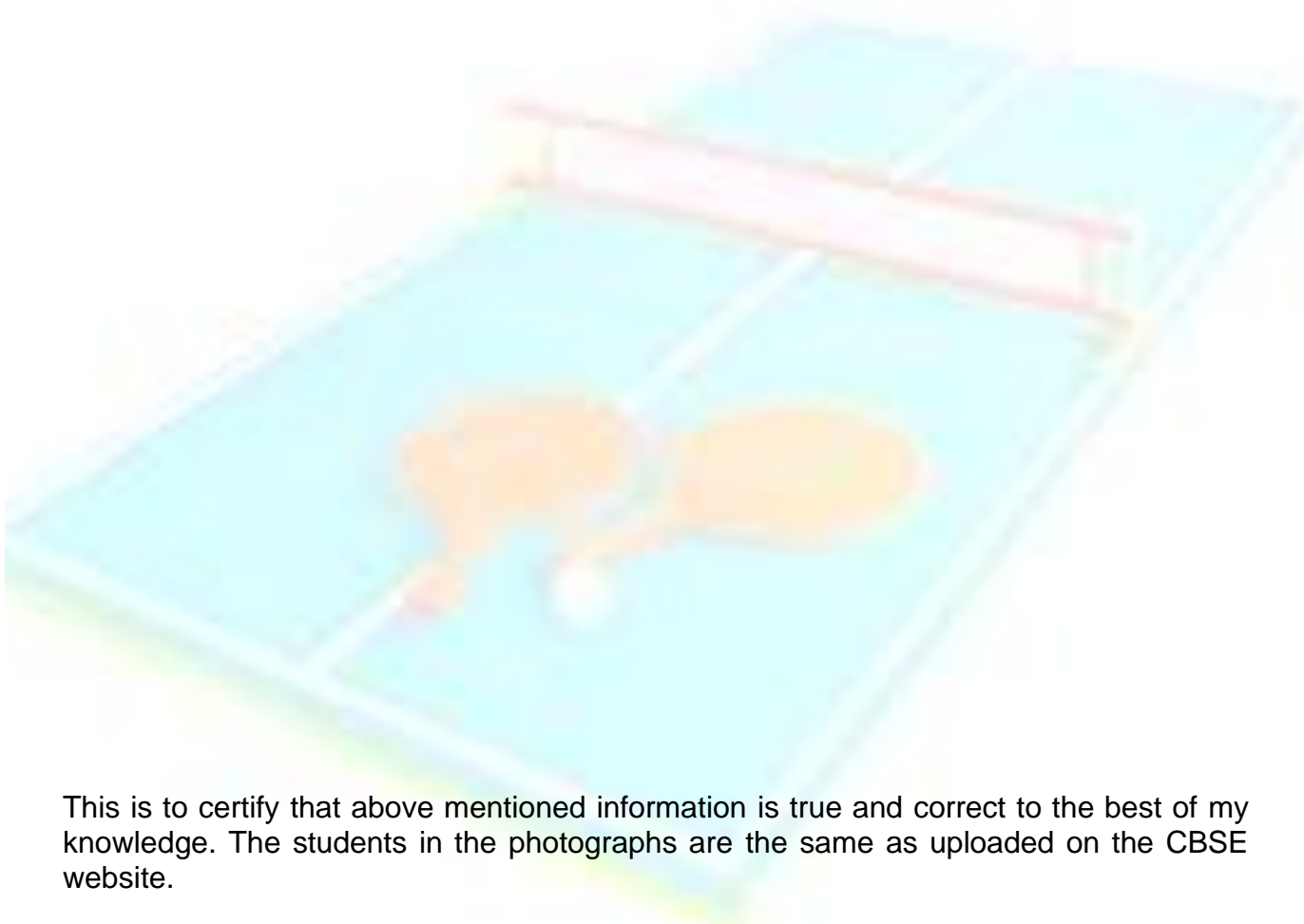

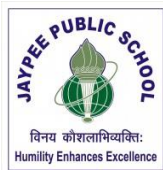

ANNEXURE - G

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. No school will be permitted to participate, unless they fill the online discipline-wise entry Proforma.
2. All expenses on items like travel, food, kit etc will have to be borne by the participating school. Players are advised to carry their own travel & personal kit as the same shall not be provided by host school.
3. Dining in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation. Players/participants are advised to follow the timings of the dining area strictly and are advised not to indulge in unhealthy food/ drinks.
4. Every player/team shall carry with them the required documents as mentioned by CBSE.
5. Participation in March past is compulsory, failing to which the right to participate can be forfeited; every team shall carry its school flag, for the purpose of March past which is to be used during the various ceremonies.
6. It is the responsibility of the school/teams staying outside, to collect information in regard to matches/fixtures/program etc.
7. In case the player/team is being accompanied only by the parent; it should be informed by the principal of participating school in writing on a letter head in advance.
8. All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school principal. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials. In case of girl participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.
9. All the participating teams shall compete in the Inter-School tournament in their respective playing uniform with the prescribed color of their school and should be numbered.
10. A junior player can be permitted to play in senior age group, and then the participation in the original group will be forfeited.
11. On the spot entry and late entry will not be entertained.

12. If a school, after filling-in its entry, wishes to withdraw from a tournament/meet, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the Organizing Secretary/School. School withdrawing without informing/requesting the Organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs.1000/-.
13. A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
14. Violation in eligibility, non-bonafide student, incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
15. Medical checkup may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the cases of overage suspicion.
16. All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation. The player's right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.
17. A player/team may be disqualified/scratched if the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected or if there is an inclusion of non bonafide student in the team or on the basis of misbehavior on ground by player or accompanying official or use of abusive language by player or accompanying official or misbehavior with Officials/Opponents by player or accompanying official.
18. **It shall be mandatory for all the participating schools to provide original documents if asked for,**
 - (a) **team photo with school principal along with the entry performa countersigned by the concerned Principal.**
 - (b) **CBSE registration number for student/player studying in class IX and above, the eligibility performa filled-in online, countersigned by the concerned principal.**
 - (c) **Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt with according to rules.**
19. A player/team may be disqualified/scratched if indiscipline is created at the place of stay by the player or accompanying official or they damage the school property or indiscipline is created during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by the player or accompanying official or if they don't participate in March Past.
20. Male accompanying officials /players are not allowed to enter female accompanying official's /player's rooms.

21. Players are advised to maintain hygiene at all times during their stay at the host school.
22. Players & accompanying officials are to make sure to not to hurt anyone's self-esteem or engage in any kind of ragging or inappropriate behavior if done so, strict action shall be taken by the host school. Misbehavior in any form during the tournament shall be avoided.
23. Consumption of liquor, drugs, tobacco and smoking is strictly prohibited during the tournament and stay in the School & JIIT premises. Anyone who violates this rule will be immediately have to leave the school campus and disciplinary action will be taken by the host school.
24. At the time of arrival, participating schools have to deposit Rs. 2000/- as caution money for any loss or damage to organizing school property, which is refundable.
25. Participants are not allowed to wear any costly ornaments or bring any valuable items. The School will not be responsible for the loss of any article during stay.
26. At the time of registration kindly show the photocopy of demand draft of the CBSE Yearly Sports Registration Fee (2019-20) of Rs.10,000/-.
27. It is compulsory to carry school Identity Card and CBSE Player Card (UID, for the tournament venue) attested by their own school as well as by the host school. No player will be permitted to participate in the tournament without the same. A copy of attested UID/CBSE Player ID card to be submitted at the time of registration.
28. The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school principal. Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises. Escorting teachers/coaches and managers or any other staff members are also requested to carry their school Identity card and Visitor card (issued by host school) all the time.

UPDATED RULES TABLE TENNIS (BOYS" & GIRLS)

1. All the matches will be played according to the rules of the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) as adopted by them from time to time, with modifications wherever applicable.
2. Every school can send one team comprising of maximum four players, in Under 14, Under 17 & Under 19 yrs separately in Boys" & Girls" category.
3. In Boys" Category, the team shall consist of maximum four & minimum two players.
4. In Girls" Category, the team shall consist of maximum four & minimum two **players**.
5. **The order of play shall be as follows:**

(iii)	Double s			(iii)	Doubles		
(iv)	A	v/s	Y	(iv)	A	v/s	Y

7. The matches up to quarter final stage will be played as best of three games. Semi final & final matches will be played as best of five games.
8. The balls to be used in the tournament shall be ITTF approved.
9. The remaining teams shall be distributed with the Participation Certificates.
10. From each Cluster, the First position winning teams in each age group, separately in Boys" & Girls category, shall qualify to participate in the Nationals.
11. No change in composition of team from Cluster level to National level will be allowed.
12. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams/Individual Players that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
13. At Cluster level the tournament will be organized on knock out basis.
14. At National level team championship shall be organized on league cum knock out basis.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP - AT CLUSTER & NATIONAL LEVELS

- (b) In addition to the team championship, separate Individual Championship will be conducted at each Cluster level.
- (c) At Cluster & National levels, the Individual Championship shall be organized on knock out basis.
- (d) In Cluster level Individual Championship, one player to play in Individual Championship in each category separately for boys & girls.

- (e) The scoring system will be the same.
- (f) From each Cluster, the first position winning player of Individual Championship shall qualify to participate in the Nationals.

IMPORTANT

1. Players can take time out for one minute, once in whole match.
2. Expedite system shall come into operation if a game is unfinished after 10 minutes play. If the expedite system is introduced, all subsequent games of the match shall be played under the expedite system.
3. Play shall be continuous throughout a match except that a player is entitled to:
 - (a) An interval of up to one minute between successive games of a match.
 - (b) Brief intervals for toweling after 6 points from the start of each game and at the change of ends in the last possible game of a match.
4. In each age group, as per TTFI ranking list, the top ten ranking players shall be eligible to play directly at National level in "Individual Championship". However, if any player, ranking in top ten, has played at respective Cluster level Individual Championship, and has lost, shall no more be eligible to participate in Individual championship at National level.
