

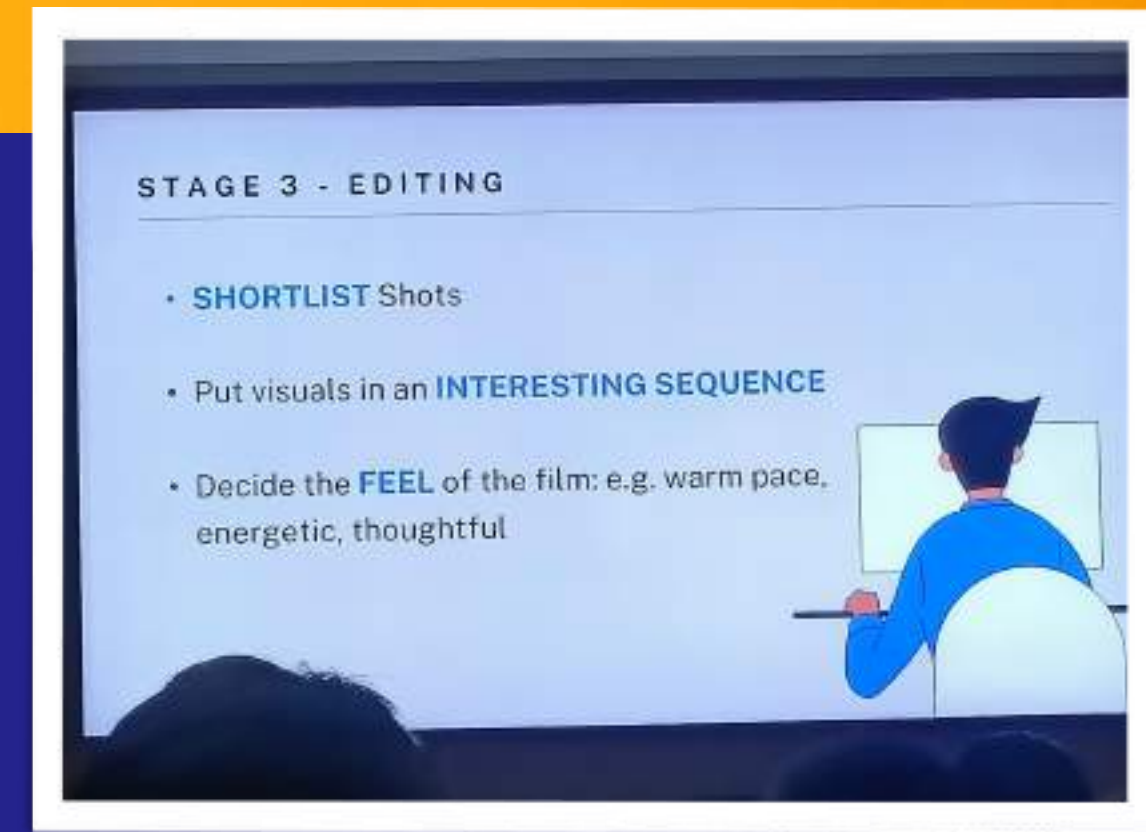
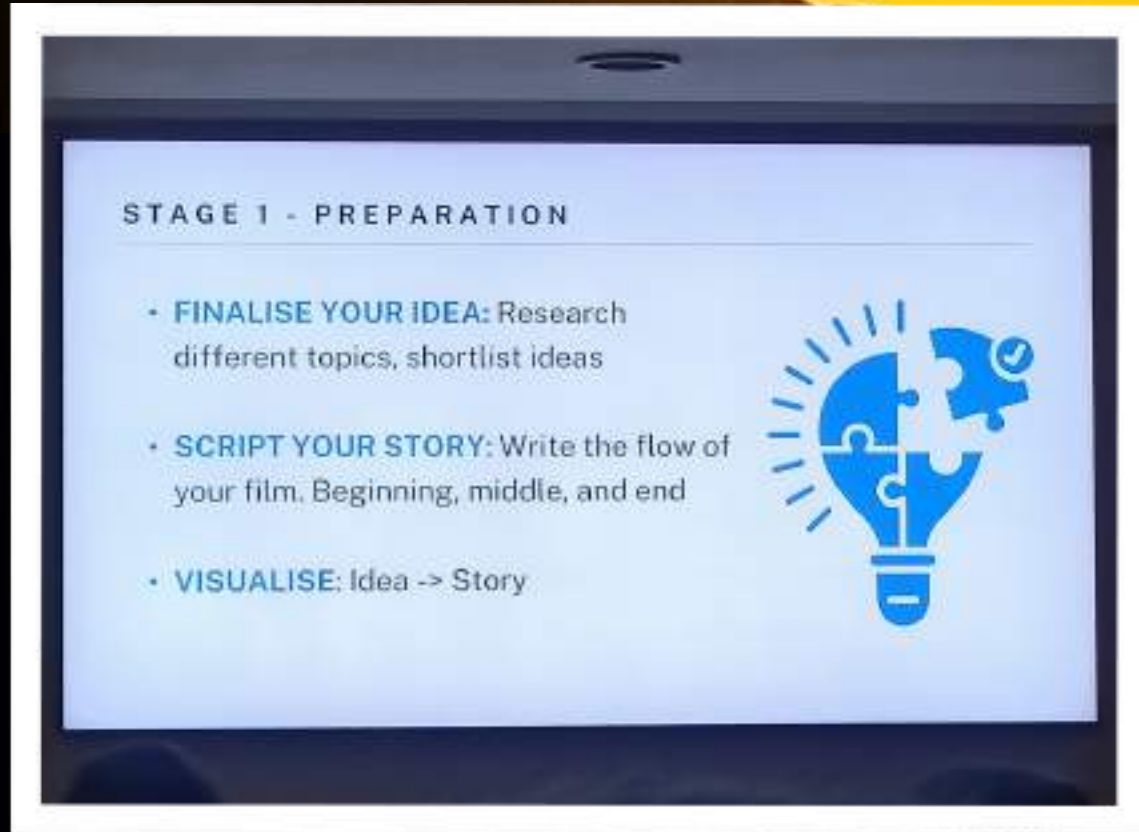


Filmit Technical Workshop Organised by INTACH

Camera Techniques

The workshop began with a session on various camera shots, crucial for effective storytelling in films. The following types of shots were demonstrated and practiced:

Wide Angle Shot: Used to capture a broad view of the scene, providing context and setting the stage.

Cut Out Shot: This shot focuses on a specific part of the scene or subject, often used for emphasis.

Close Shot: Captures the subject closely, highlighting details and expressions.

Mid Shot: Balances the scene and the subject, often used for dialogues and interactions.

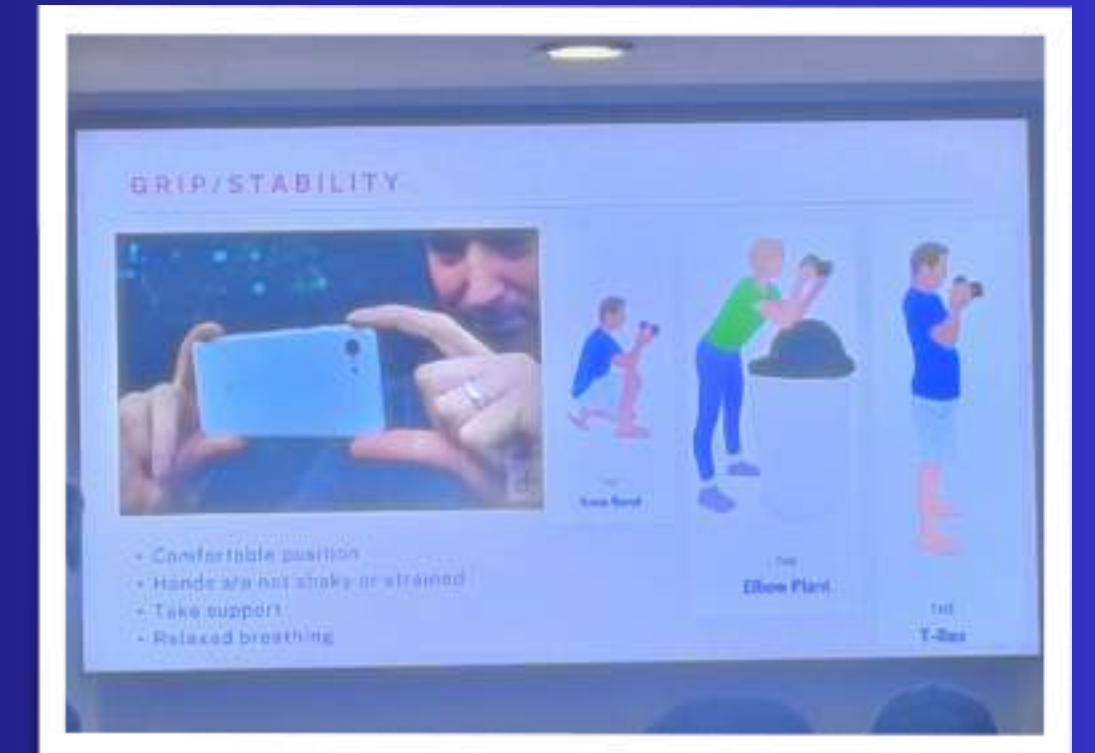
The participants were given hands-on practice with these shots, enabling them to understand their practical applications in filmmaking.

Sound Design

- **Background Music:** Setting the tone and mood of the scene.
- **Sound Effects:** Enhancing realism and engagement.
- **Dialogue Recording:** Ensuring clarity and coherence.
- **Ambient Sounds:** Adding depth and immersion to scenes
